



## **NH KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS 2007 STATE FAMILY CAMPOREE**

### **GENERAL RULES & INFORMATION**

Welcome to the 34<sup>th</sup> annual NH Knights of Columbus State Family Camporee, and to Camp Fatima, nestled in the Gilmanton woods and along the sapphire-blue Upper Suncook Lake. This is a family weekend for New Hampshire knights and their families and friends. This annual event is made possible through the great cooperation of the Diocese of Manchester, and therefore requires our full attention to making it the safest, most pleasant experience possible for everyone. Your party's compliance with these campground regulations is sincerely appreciated:

**For children's safety, the speed limit throughout Camp Fatima is 5 MPH.**

**Quiet Time is after 10:30 PM. All audio/video devices are to be turned off or have their volume lowered.**

**Alcoholic beverages are permitted only at the camper's site, alcohol is prohibited at all other common areas. Kegs, illegal narcotics, and providing alcohol to minors are absolutely prohibited.**

**Pets are permitted only at the camper's site. All pets must be leashed in accordance with the Gilmanton leash law. Campers are required to remove and dispose of all pet waste.**

**Campfires must be kept small. Campfire privileges may be removed if necessary. All campfire areas must be watered down and cleaned before leaving Monday.**

**Firearms are prohibited. Air rifles may only be used for the BB Gun Shoot.**

**If it is necessary to move campground equipment to a different location, please return it to its original place when finished. Beds/mattresses may not be removed from cabins.**

**Police officers regularly patrol the campground and surroundings.**

**Trash dumpsters are located near the side of the Dining Hall. Place all trash in plastic bags and deposit it in the dumpsters before leaving. Campground staff inspect all cabins and campsites afterwards.**

**Mass will be celebrated by State Chaplain Father Agapit Jean on Sunday at 5:30 PM at the campground chapel. All campers are invited to attend. Those who will not be attending are asked to ensure quiet during this time, as noise is especially distracting and disrespectful.**

### **WATERFRONT REGULATIONS**

**THERE IS NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY. ALL SWIMMING AND BOATING IS DONE AT THE CAMPER'S OWN RISK.**

**All children must be supervised by their parent or guardian when at the waterfront.**

**Swimming areas and boating areas have been designated. In the interest of safety, no swimmers are permitted in the boating area – and no boats permitted in the swimming area.**

**Glass containers and products are prohibited at the waterfront.**

**Waterfront/dock is closed after 9:30 PM. No campers allowed in the beach area after that time.**

**MILFOIL ALERT: Milfoil is a dangerous aquatic weed which could potentially damage botanic and animal life around lakes. Please be sure to completely clean your boat and trailer of all vegetation BEFORE AND AFTER launching it into the water. Avoid running your boat through any large patches of plants when on the lake.**
